The Good Samaritan Story

Plan for a short role play with the children as a group playing some role in the story (something to say, something to do). You may wish to show pictures from a good Bible storybook. The ARCH® book (Item #21607) for this story is great, showing pictures and telling the story in poem-style. Make sure the “point” of the story is clear to the children!
